### **NOVEMBER 21 REPORT, Stacy Park**

After canceling the original date due to heavy rain, we had a terrific turnout on Nov 18 for clearing invasives out of the Stacy Park Prairie. When volunteers arrived, there were large sections of green denoting bush honeysuckle. It stood out easily amidst the native grasses and plants that were already dormant. Volunteers were able to easily walk into the prairie using the mowed pathways. This helped them get in close, and to remove the cuttings afterward.

Within the two hours of work, all the green sections were gone! The volunteers achieved much more that we thought possible! **Thank you everyone!!**

Bush Honeysuckle leafs out first in the spring, and loses its leaves last in the fall, which helps it out compete native plants. But this also makes it really easy to spot when trying to get rid of it! Fall is a perfect time to attack Bush Honeysuckle!
